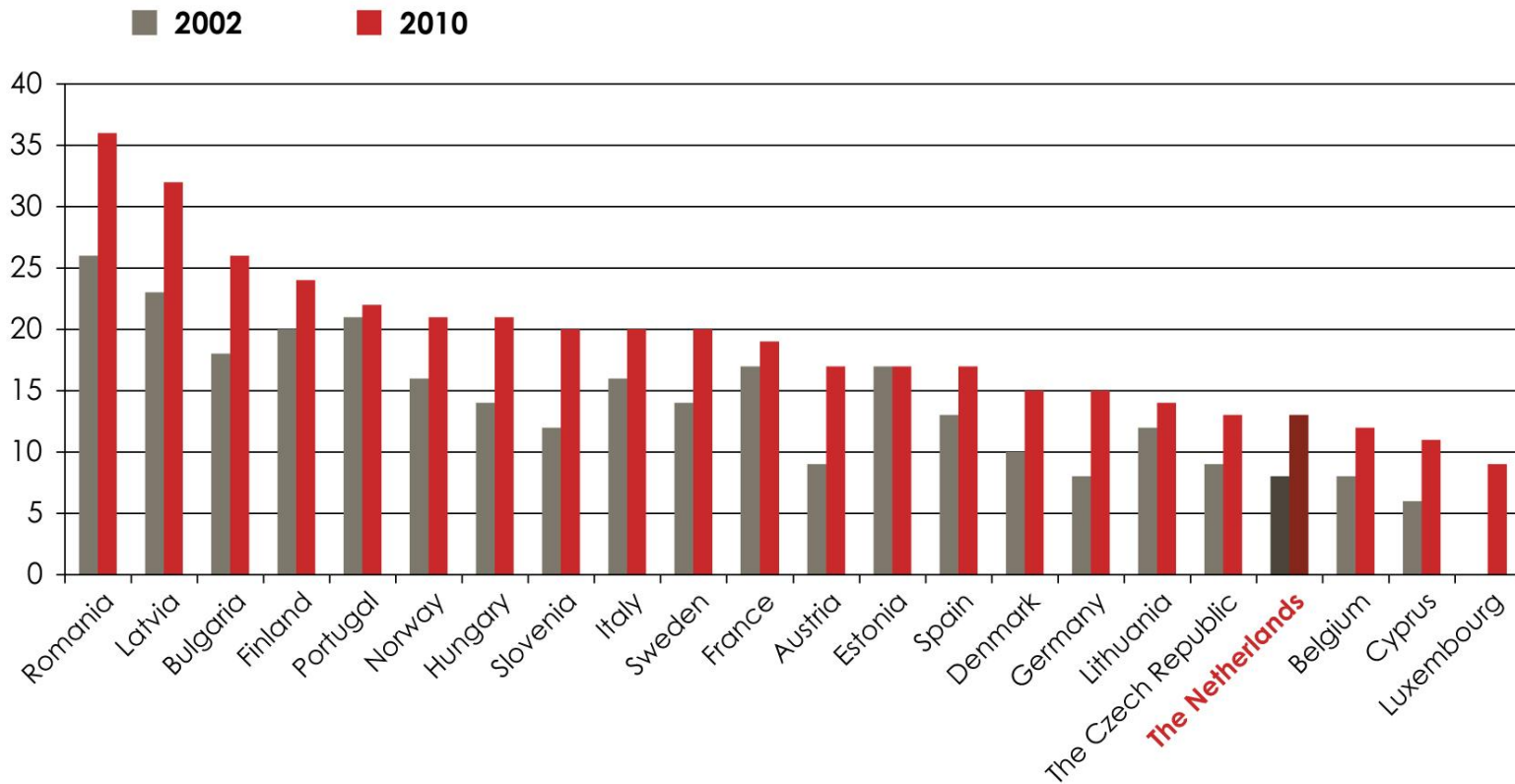

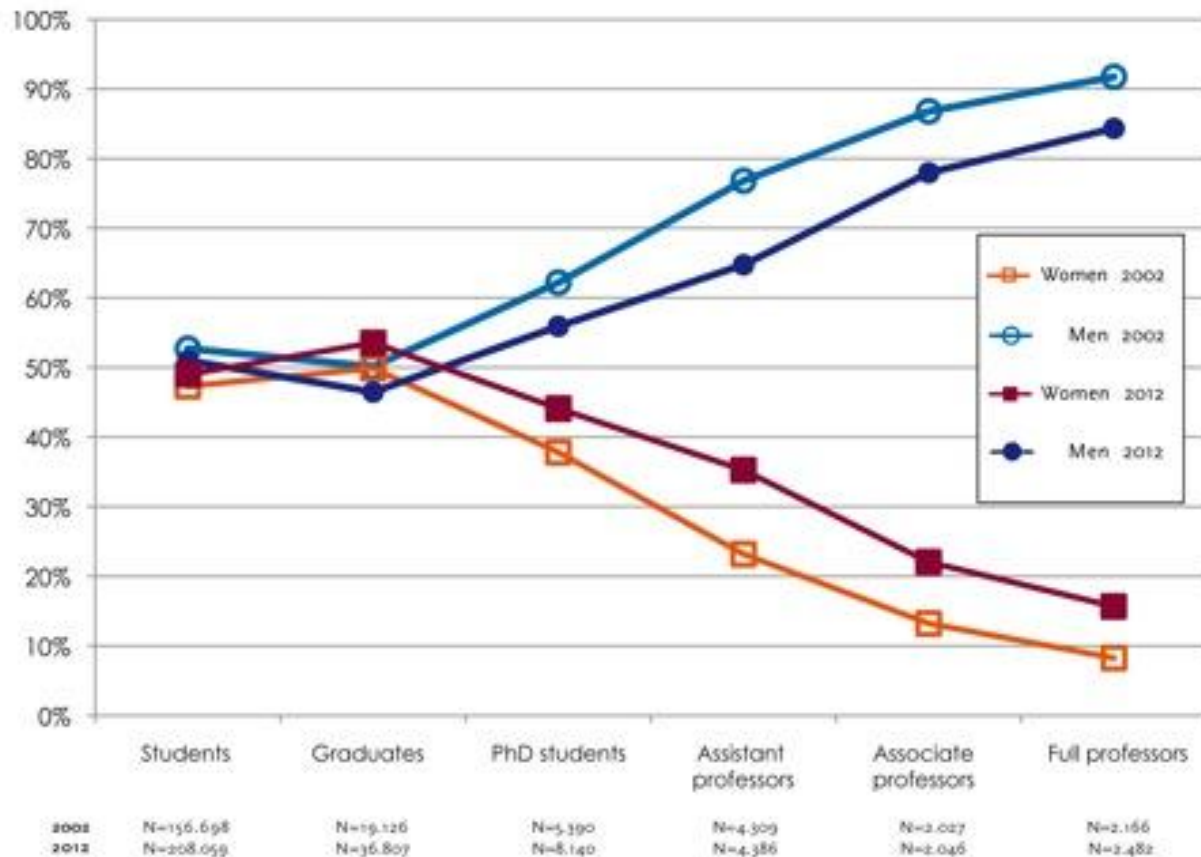

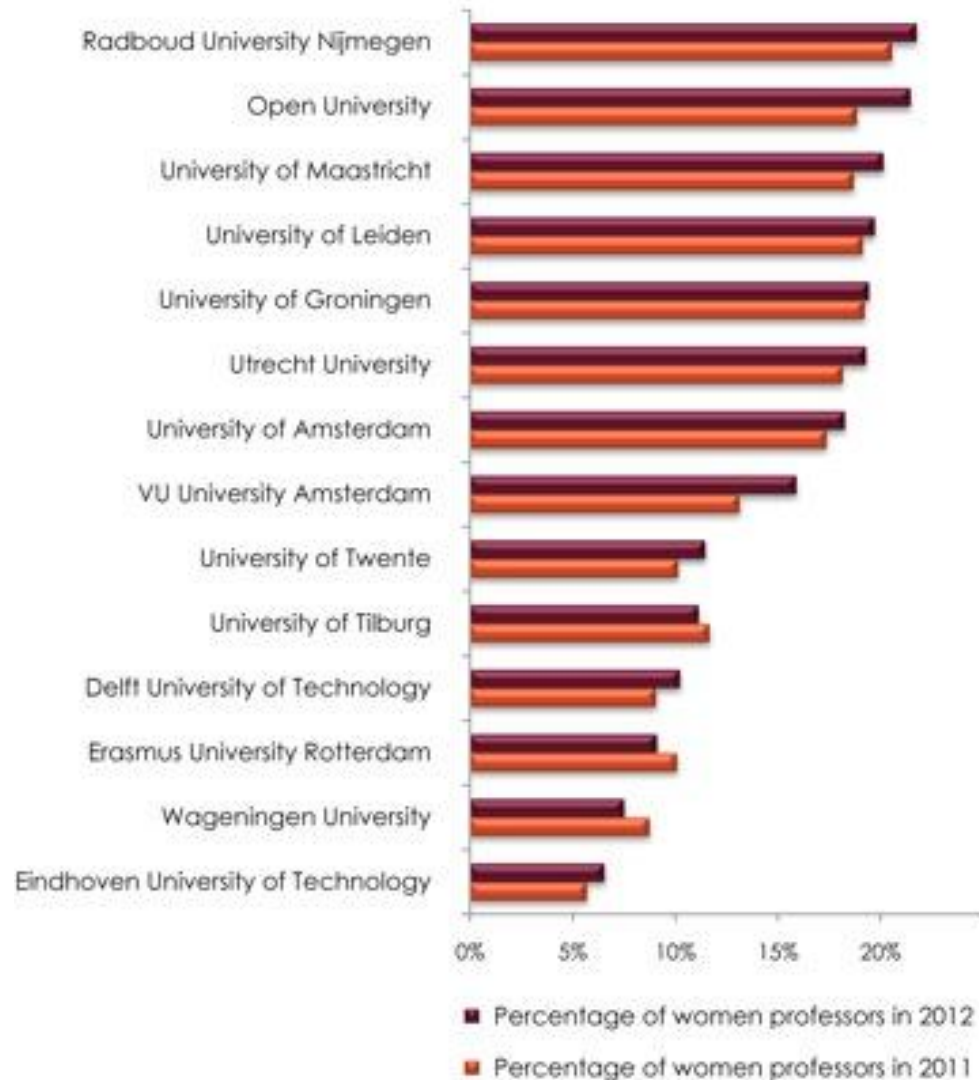
Percentage of women professors (Grade A Academic Positions) in EU27 countries in 2002 and 2010



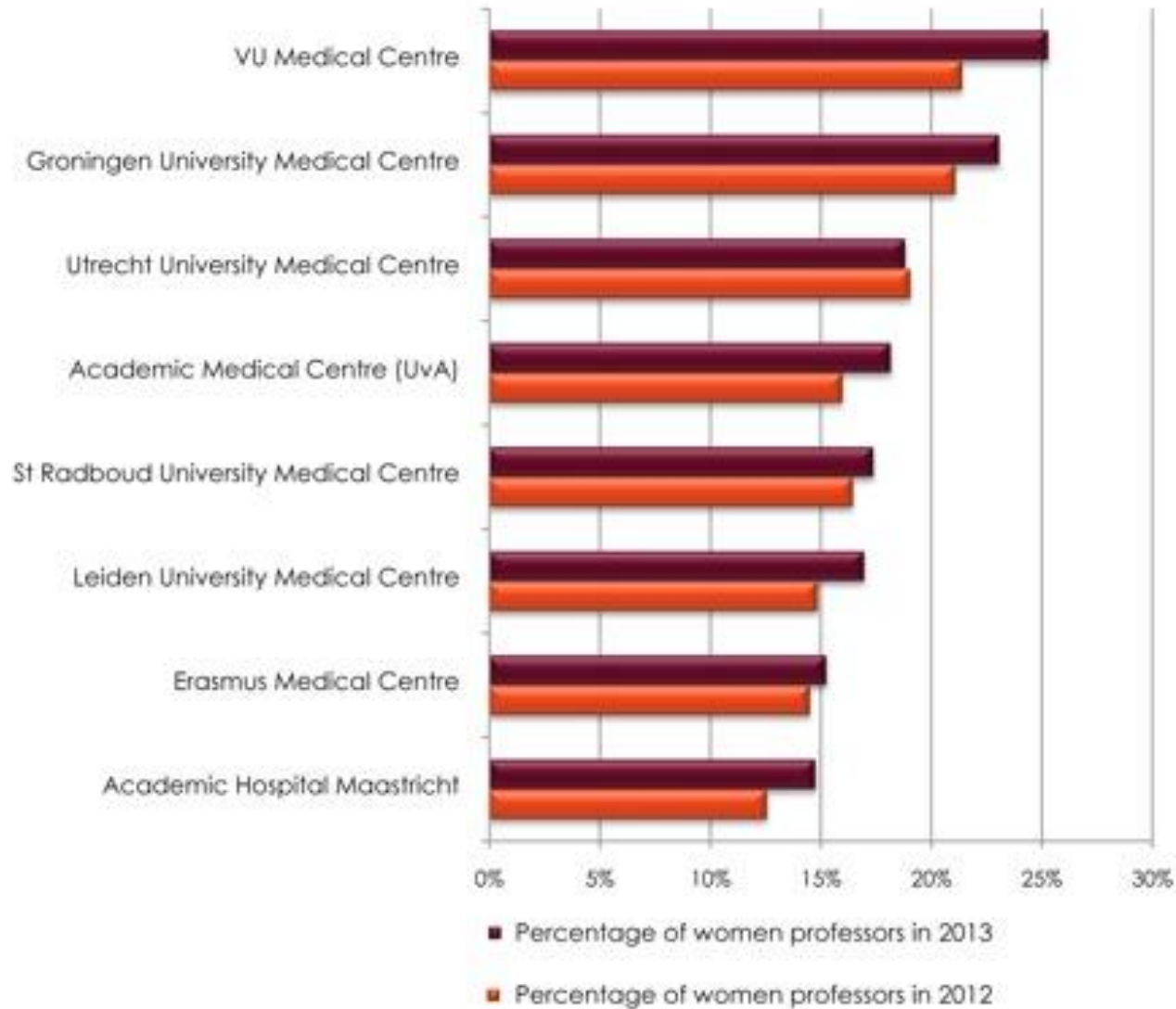
Gender distribution of enrolled students, graduates, PhD students, assistant professors, associate professors and full professors at the end of 2002 and 2012



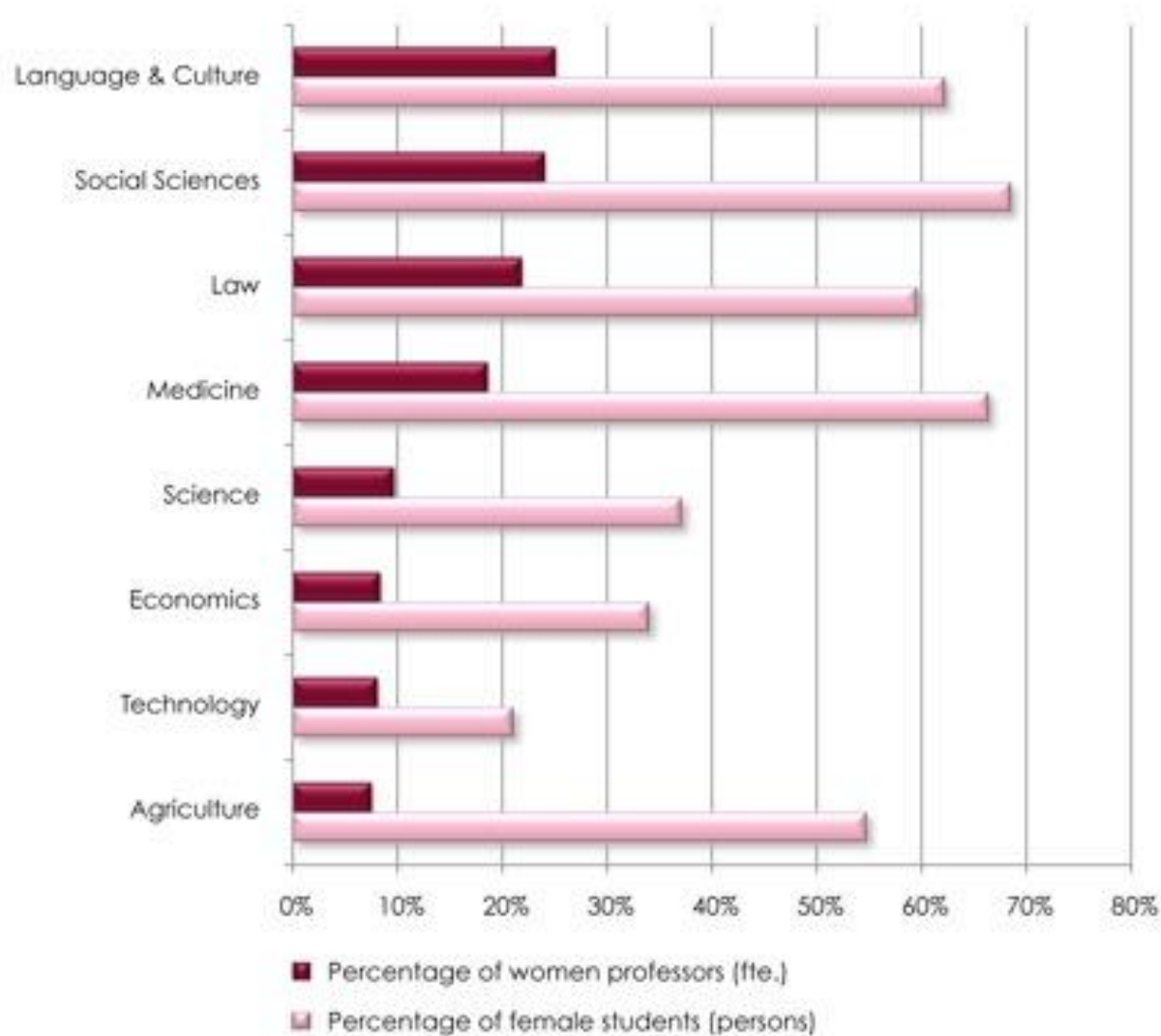
Percentage of women professors by universities in 2011 and 2012



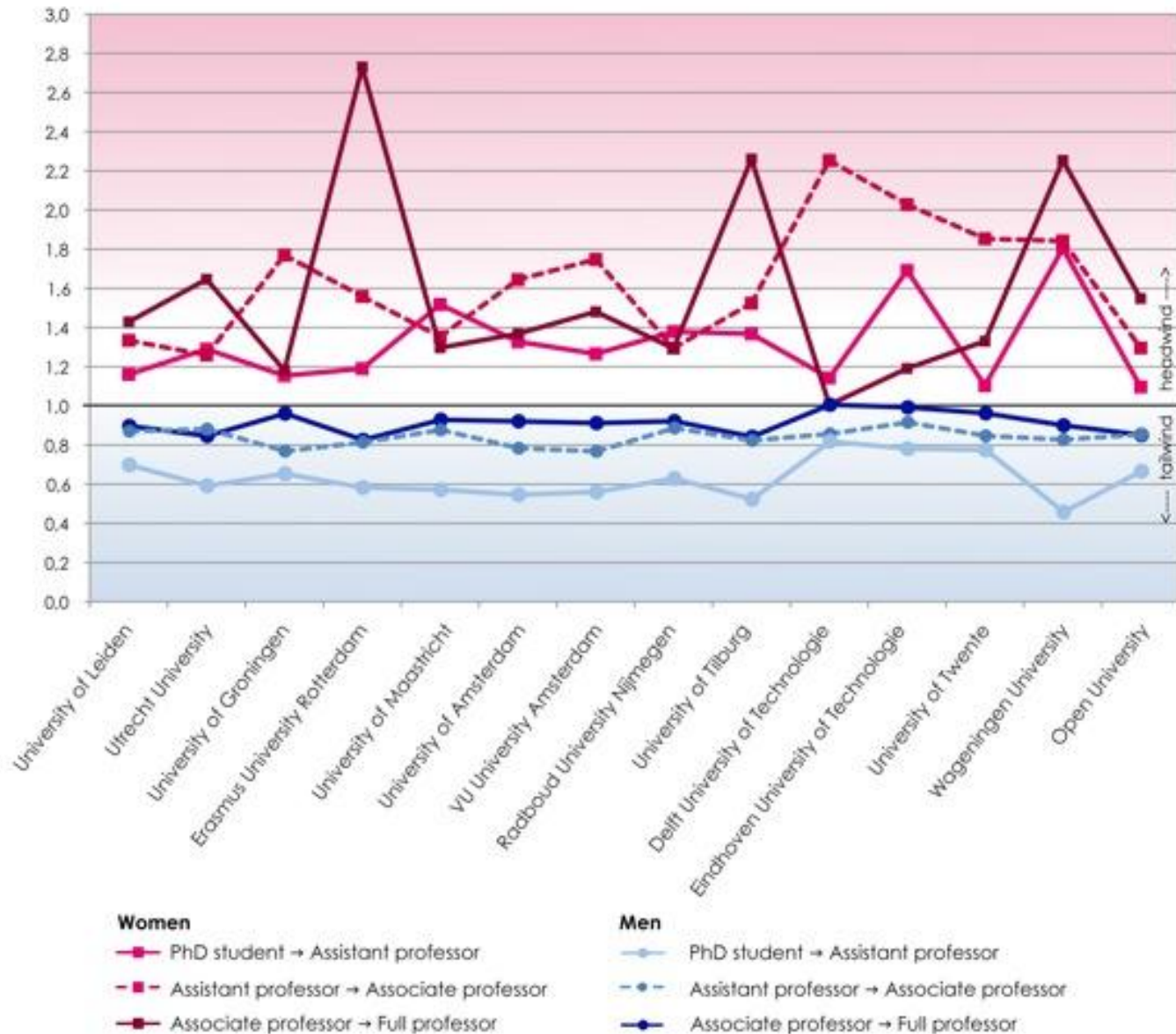
Percentage of women professors by university medical centres in 2012 and 2013



Percentage of women professors and female students by academic field in 2012-2013



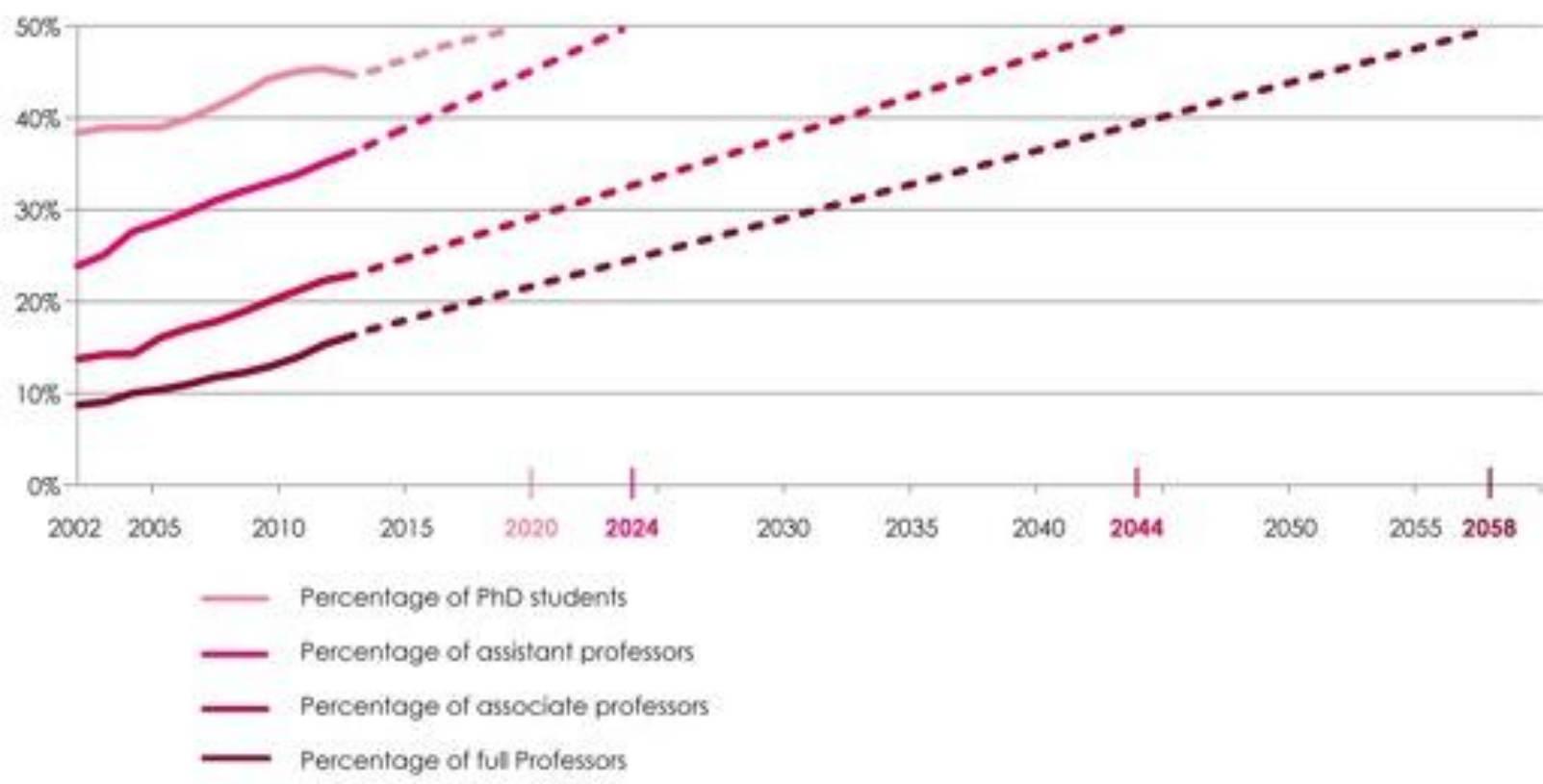
Glass Ceiling Index for women and men by university
